"IMMORTAL MIRROR"

In my latest collection, "IMMORTAL MIRROR," I aimed to unveil a fresh essence of the mirror by exploring its defining layers and its intricate relationship with the audience Metaphorically,I posit that "THE IMAGE IN THE MIRROR IS IMMORTAL," asserting that with each encounter the audience has with the mirror, their image becomes eternally imprinted upon it. Embracing this abstract belief, the mirror takes on the role of a memory bank, capturing the passage of time layer by layer. As time progresses, these layers accumulate, unveiling a mysterious tapestry of images on the mirror's reflective surface. A single gaze at the mirror arrests time before one's eyes, allowing the audience to perceive themselves in the present, juxtaposed against past moments and an infinite array of recorded images within the mirror's layers. The inherent haziness of the present image, a consequence of the mirror's filled memory, prompts contemplation on the nature of time, fostering a unique interaction between the audience and the mirror as a reflective medium. Transitioning from abstraction to tangibility, I conducted extensive research and experimentation to create a mirror that, through a chemical oxidization process, mimics the passage of time. This innovative mirror, akin to a handcrafted abstract painting, offers a distinct expression of the materiality of mirrors.

The evolved forms, marked by fluidity and complexity, stem from the humble triangle, emphasizing the fundamental nature of the mirror. Although inherently simple, the mirror becomes a captivating focal point, inviting prolonged contemplation. Recognizing the immortality of the mirrored image sparks new realms of fantasy.

By introducing texture to the mirror's original structure and inducing oxidation, I introduced complexity. Curving the edges of the triangular forms further amplifies the intricacy of the piece. The transformation of the straightforward two-dimensional triangle into a mesh of curved sides results in a contemporary and original geometry. Covered with mirrors that exude an aged and enigmatic aura, the artwork projects a fresh image of the audience.


In every encounter, they are confronted with the task of framing a piece of themselves while seeking another in the present moment, a process heightened by the visual intensity of the disintegration and fragmentation of their image within the complex form.

Engaging with these artworks allows the audience to grasp three facets of time: decoding hidden layers within the mirror's aged texture for glimpses into the past, scrutinizing the details of present forms, and envisioning the future by creating new fantasies of immortalized images among oxidized layers.








































IMMORTAL MIRROR 07 2024 Oxadised Mirror, Polymer, Plexi Glass 180 x 65 cm Edition: 3 + AP










MIRROR 1 2013 Mirror, Polymer, Plexiglass 140 x 140 x 49 cm Edition: 1 + AP












































MIRROR 10 2022 Mirror, Polymer, Wood 140 x 140 x 7 cm Edition: 3 + AP















Biography

Aref Montazeri was born in Tehran, Iran in 1986. He is a sculptor removed from conventional practices, he pursues a novel approach to mirror art that involves large numbers of mirror cuts and meticulous attention to detail. Conceptually, he follows an approach he has termed "The MIRROR follows narrative", which favors materialism over ornamentalism and resilience of design over buildability.

His design apparatus consists of three criteria: Narrative, Material and Technique. Which is also the way he looks at art and creates it.

He started his training during the time he collaborated with Monir Shahroudy Farmanfarmaian on the design and fabrication of around 60 sculptures (2009-15).

Additionally, he was involved in fabrication of Parviz Tanavoli's sculptures and jewelries (2012-14). He has also been an artist-in-residence at TUIC, contributing to research projects in innovative materials and smart techniques. Notably, his residency with the Maleki Collection in France resulted in the creation of three significant sculptures, including the intricate "PARADOX" composed of 70,000 mirror pieces.
