Symphony of Birds

My paintings draw inspiration from the genre of Persian painting known as 'Negargari,' particularly focusing on the fusion of flowers and birds. However, they transcend the confines of traditional Iranian painting, embracing a modern essence to better engage with today's world. In Iranian painting, the delicate combination of flowers and birds creates harmony between the elements of lines and imagery. The bird symbolizes love, and the flower represents the beloved, creating a continuous dialogue as if these two elements are in perpetual conversation.

This artistic tradition, dating back to the Safavid era when Iran's government and society were shaped under the influence of Shia Islam, has taken on a surreal quality. In this art, subtlety, intricacy, the gathering, and scattering of points and lines play a decisive role. In Iranian myths and folklore, the bird serves as a revealer of divine secrets and a guardian of the tree of knowledge and wisdom.

Iranian painters, relying on their inner inspirations and attention to symbolic representations, portray the bird as a trapped spirit within the confines of the body, constantly striving for liberation from the material world and reaching towards the divine. In my paintings, however, justice doesn't necessarily have a purely spiritual or metaphysical aspect; it can manifest as an aspect of this worldly and physical realm, such as justice, peace, ethical salvation, or freedom.

The paintings aim to draw attention to the contemporary human experience, offering hope, embracing humanity in the face of oppression and injustice, and nurturing it towards a better future. They dream of a better tomorrow for people, weaving dreams for a world that reconsiders its course. The art seeks to heal the wounded hearts of all beings worldwide. Essentially, it goes beyond the conventional clichés of Iranian painting, carving a niche toward a new world. This departure in my works inevitably leads to innovation in form, driven by new content. I prefer to label this as modern painting, a work of innovation that carries my unique signature.




The mountains are together and alone 2023









Inevitably Parallel 2023 Acrylic on canvas 250 x 180 cm







Redemption 2020 Acrylic, Watercolor, Cardborad 97 x 67 cm





Tree of friendship 2019 Acrylic, Watercolor, Cardborad 67 x 50 cm












You & Me 2022 Acrylic, Canvas 120 x 85 cm




Wet Flowers 2020 Acrylic, Watercolor, Cardboard 39 x 30 cm






Mirror of heart 2020 Acrylic, Watercolor, Cardboard 40 x 30 cm


Tradition of killing the Lover 2022 Acrylic, Watercolor, Cardboard 39 x 30 cm






