Royal Caribbean (RCL) and International Corporate Art (ICArt) invite you to experience the singular and eclectic art collection curated for Anthem of the Seas celebrating the timeless question, "What Makes Life Worth Living (WMLWL)."

Encompassing approximately 3,000 works of art, with many created specifically for this vessel, the collection explores, aesthetically and conceptually, the tangible and timeless qualities of life — People, Leisure, Fashion, Arts & Literature, Food, Adventure, Entertainment & Nature.

Resulting from RCL's mission to create the world's most sustainable class of ships to date, ICArt, as curators of the art program, feel that developing an art experience revolving around the "red thread" or theme of "WMLWL", best supports and highlights this vision.

Royal Caribbean has a long history of showcasing original art at sea, and currently has one of the world's largest corporate art collections featured throughout their fleet. Inclusive of a wide array of mediums such as painting, sculpture, works on paper, photography and video, the artworks featured on Anthem of the Seas are captivating, interactive and stunningly beautiful.

Including artists from all over the world, some of the unique works in the collection include Marrakesh-based, French-born, Jean Francois Fourtou's 30-foot-tall, monumental giraffe, prominently situated on the exterior deck of the ship. With its canary yellow bathing suit and pink lifesaver, this surprisingly humorous creature welcomes guests. British artist, Richard Hudson's monumental, mirrored steel sculpture titled Eve, regally presides as the central feature in the Via; and Ran Hwang's


mesmerizing jewel-like clusters of crystal cherry blossoms along the Aft Lift Lobby Wall titled **Healing Garden**, create a sense of movement and grace.


Also featuring a selection of the latest in technology based, interactive, "smart art" works, Anthem of the Seas creates another first-at-sea onboard experience. Rafael Lozano Hemmer's interactive installation Pulse Spiral, a grand chandelier made up of 200 light bulbs pulsating rhythmically to heartbeats recorded by the sensor beneath, transforms a physical, tactile sensation into a visual, illuminating one. In his lively and striking light installation, Sustained Fireworks, James Clar creates a never-ending fireworks show. Words explode, expand and fade out, much like one's recollection of life experiences. One by one, these experiences, both big and small, burst into the viewer's memory as one watches, wide-eyed, and remembers each moment, then waits for the next, trying to anticipate what it will be.




