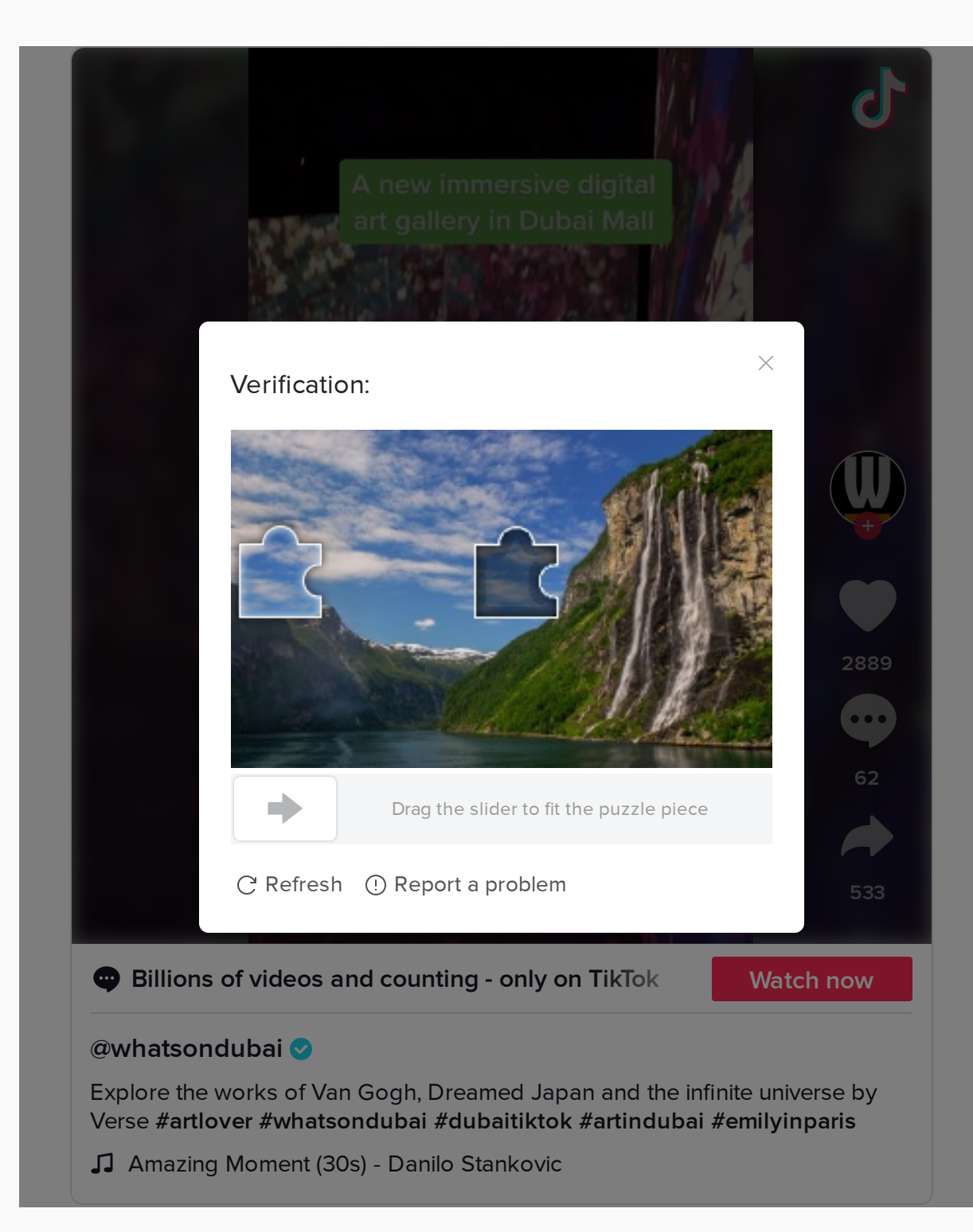
Calling all culture vultures!

When: July 1 onwards

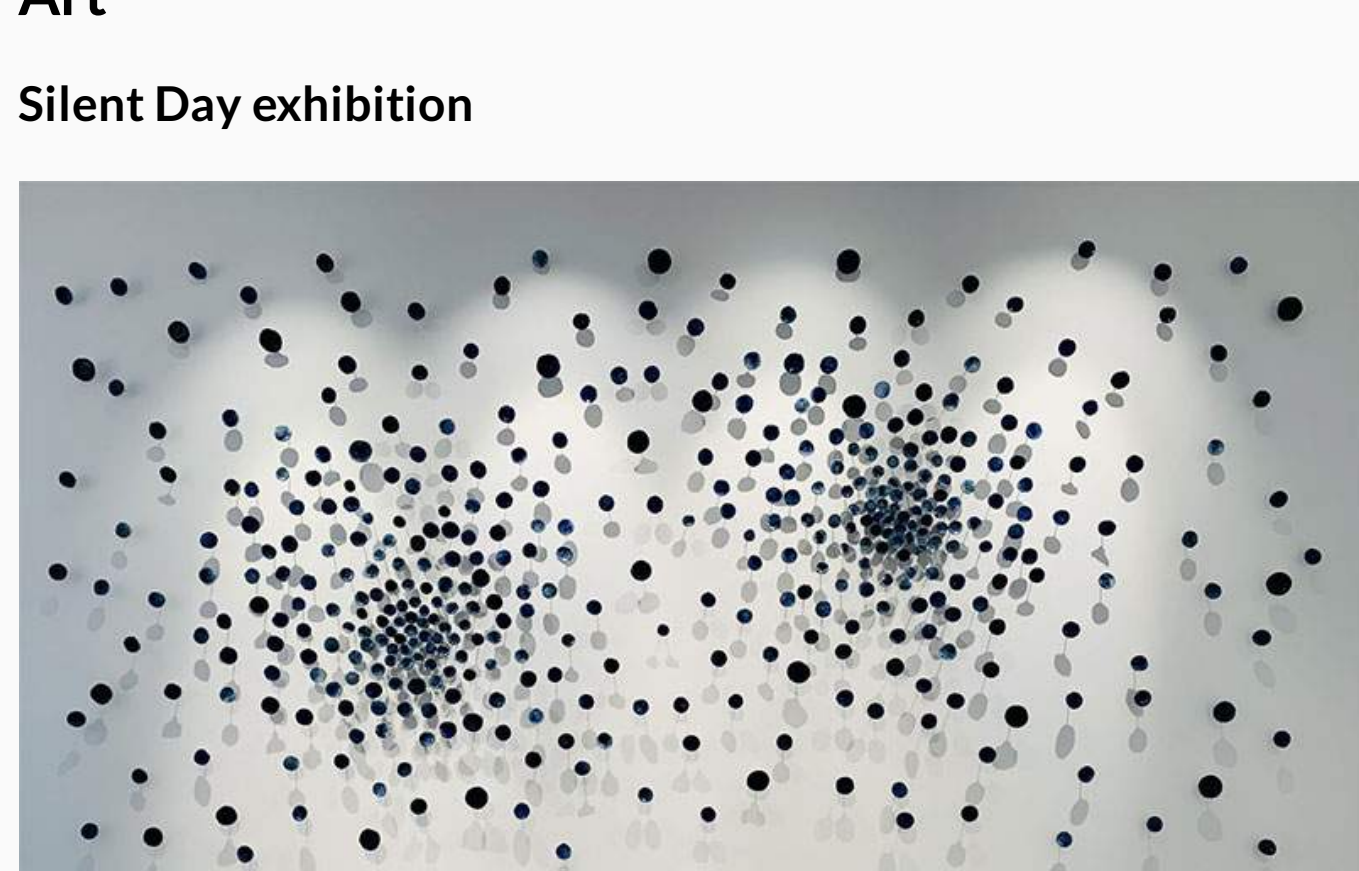

When: July 1 onwards

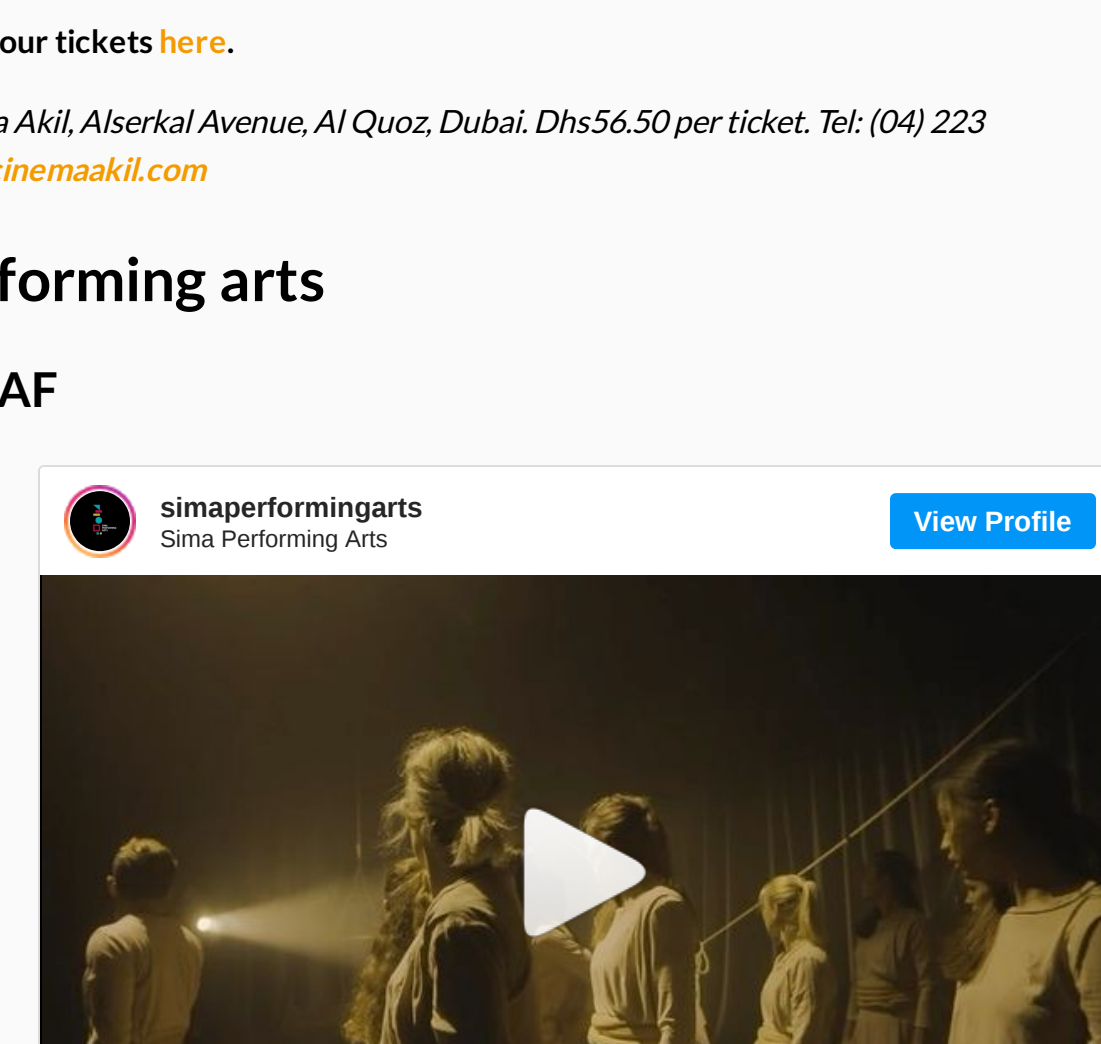
