ISTANBUL.- ArtInternational announced the selected works for By The Waterside, the fair's dedicated sculpture terrace spanning the length of the Halic Congress Center's waterfront on Istanbul's historic Golden Horn.

A highlight of the inaugural edition of ArtInternational in 2013, By the Waterside consists of artworks approved by ArtInternational's selection committee from applications by the fair's participating galleries.
