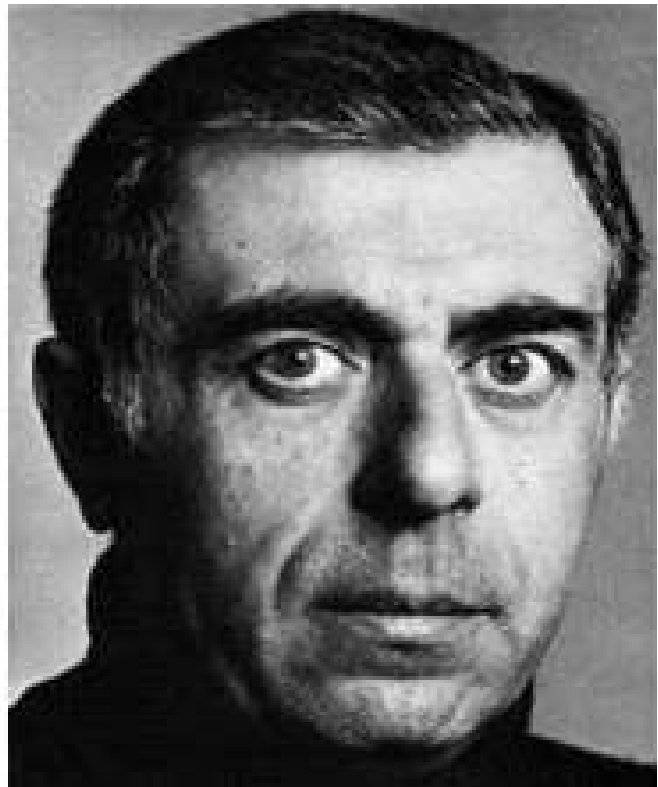

BAHMAN MOHASSES

Iranian, 1931-2010

Bahman Mohasses was a leading voice in 20th-century Iranian modernism, renowned for his contributions to painting, sculpture, theater, and literary translation. Educated at the Accademia di Belle Arti in Rome, Mohasses brought a refined European sensibility to his art, blending elements of surrealism, expressionism, and classical mythology with a uniquely personal aesthetic. His sculptures, often large-scale bronze figures, are known for their powerful, distorted forms, while his paintings evoke themes of solitude, absurdity, and the fragility of human existence. Mohasses exhibited widely, including at the Venice Biennale, and was a key figure in Iran's Saqqakhaneh movement, which reinterpreted traditional motifs through a contemporary lens. In addition to his visual art, Mohasses was a noted translator of literary giants such as Sartre and Ionesco, further demonstrating his intellectual range. Though reclusive in his later years, his influence remains deeply embedded in the trajectory of Iranian and international art.

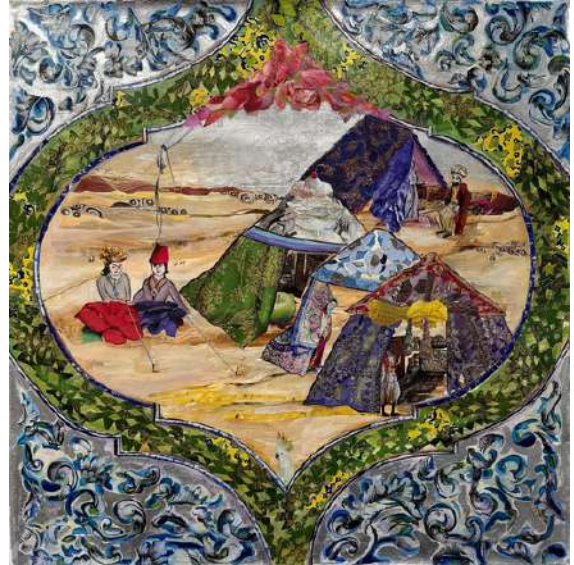

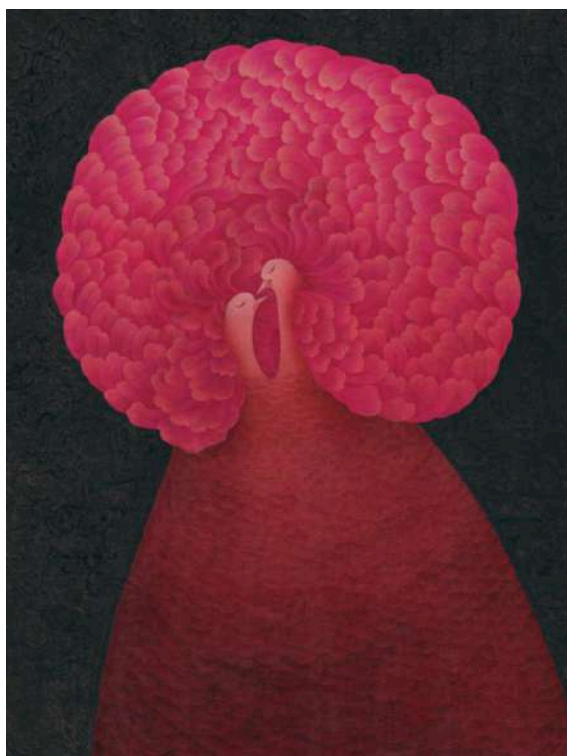

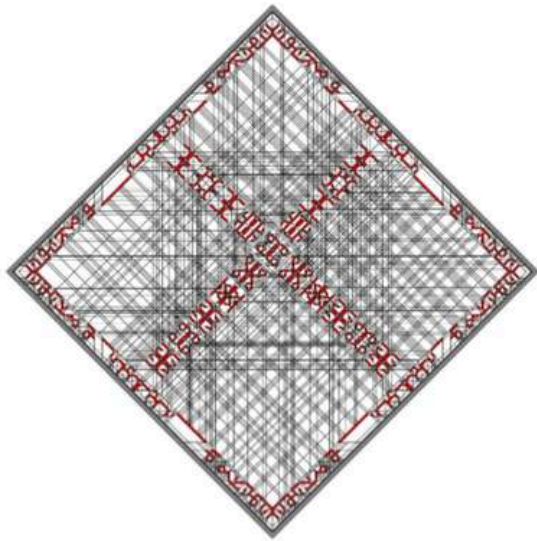

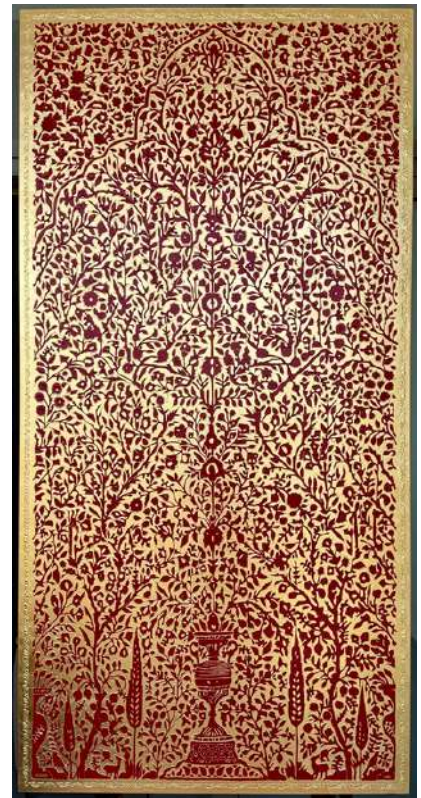

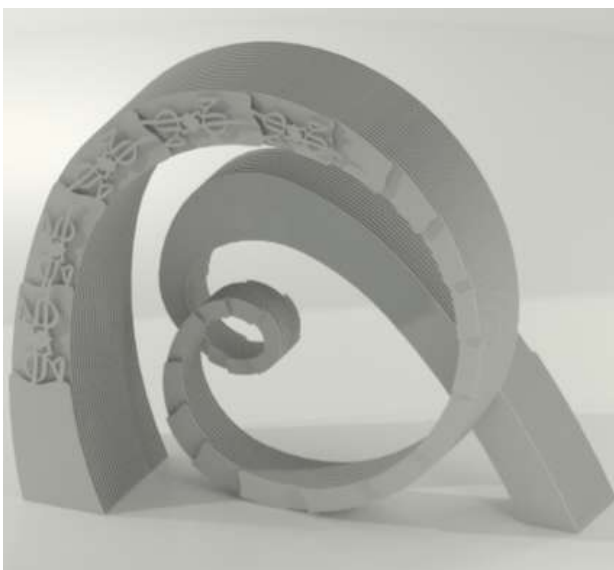
