

Wassef Boutros-Ghali (1924-2023) pursued art from a young age, training under Jaro Hilbert. He initially chose architecture but later dedicated himself to painting. His work, rooted in mythology, daily life, and dreamlike visions, embraces the pure physicality of painting.


