## Wassef Boutros Ghali ARETROSPECTIVE 1965 - 2016

Spanning several decades, these works reveal Boutros-Ghali's distinctive balance between architectural order and painterly intuition. In both the large-scale canvases and intimate paper compositions, intersecting planes, subtle tonal shifts, and spatial rhythms evoke a meditative language that transcends geography, rooted in modernist ideals.

In both mediums, Boutros-Ghali's compositions are dynamic; they seem to breathe, their tensions and harmonies suggesting the shifting light, landscapes, and cultural forms that informed his vision. His work resonates with a timeless universality yet carries the imprint of a life lived between continents.

Boutros-Ghali challenges the traditional and leading convention of figuration with his commitment to abstraction as a modernist method of self-expression. Each piece demonstrates his mastery in balancing architectural rigor with the sensibility of a painter, transforming pure geometry into a language of contemplation and a constant state of visual flux.

Challenging traditional figuration, Boutros-Ghali embraces abstraction as a modernist method of self-expression. Each work transforms pure geometry into a language of contemplation, achieving a poised equilibrium between static form and dynamic, ephemeral color a visual flux that resonates with timeless universality.









### WASSEF BOUTROS GHALI 1924 - 2023

Born in Cairo (1924–2023) to a political family, Boutros-Ghali pursued art from a young age, training under Jaro Hilbert. He initially chose architecture but later dedicated himself to painting, merging structural precision with lyrical color harmonies.

As a U.N. consultant, he worked on urban projects across the Middle East and Africa while deepening his artistic practice. Political upheaval in 1963 forced him to experiment with Chinese ink drawings, shaping his later style.

Moving to New York in 1971 revitalized his approach, shifting his focus from figurative improvisations to bold abstraction influenced by Rothko and Reinhardt. Larger canvases and vibrant acrylics became his signature. A return to Cairo in 1985 provided uninterrupted freedom to refine his meticulous yet expressive compositions.

Boutros-Ghali continued to paint until his passing on March 15, 2023, at the age of 98.
